Product/Chemical Name: DURO-TAK ADHESIVE 80-1097

Formula: Toluene 47%, Ethyl Acetate 13%, Vinyl Acetate 1%

Physical Description: Yellow liquid; typical ketone/hydrocarbon odor

Special Hazards: Self-contained breathing apparatus is recommended.

Unusual Fire/Explosion Hazards: Vapors are heavier than air & may travel a considerable distance to a source of ignition and flash back.

Reactivity: Stable. Avoid strong oxidizers, acids, bases.

Hazardous Decomposition Products: Thermal decomposition could produce carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide, and unidentified organic compounds.

Spill or Leak Procedures

Action: Take up with sand or other absorbent material.

Disposal Method: To be performed in compliance with all current local, state & Federal Regulations.

Threshold Limit Value: Ethyl Acetate 400.000 ppm (ACGIH TWA), 400.000 ppm (OSHA TWA); Vinyl Acetate 10.000 ppm (ACGIH TWA), 15.000 ppm (ACGIH STEL); Ethanol 1000.000 ppm (ACGIH TWA), 1000 ppm (OSHA TWA); n-Hexane 50.000 ppm (ACGIH TWA), 500.000 ppm (OSHA TWA)

Overexposure Effects: Irritation to skin, may cause vomiting, headache, pulmonary edema.

Potential Carcinogen: Possible cancer hazard.

First Aid Procedures

Skin: Flush with large amounts of soap and water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Eyes: Check for and remove any contact lenses. Immediately flush eyes with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes, lifting upper and lower eyelids. Get medical attention promptly.
